Training and Certificate Distribution - ChaudharyCharan Singh University and Minin University are working in collaboration to provide free Russian language training

We are pleased to announce that the course has been successfully completed for seven batches. 150 students were registered and have been certified for the course. It is also pertinent to mention here that during her stay Prof. Liudmila has organised training programs at other Universities and institutes of India. 60 students form University of The Maharaja Sayajirao University of Baroda, Vadodra (16- 22 October), 30 from Sharda University, Noida (30 October-5 November), 39 students from Delhi University (10- 16 December) and almost 181 students from JNU (9 – 22 October, 25- 30 October) have been successfully trained by her and her colleagues.
